Online (preferred) and/or sealed bids for the City of Toledo, Ohio, **MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE, REDUCTION GEAR CASE OIL REPLACEMENT** will be received by the City of Toledo, Ohio, at the Office of the Commissioner of Purchasing, 19th Floor, One Government Center, Suite 1970, Toledo, Ohio 43604, until 1:30 p.m. local time, on TUESDAY, February 24, 2015 , they will be publicly opened and read at 2:00 p.m. local time. In general, the Work consists of the furnishing of all labor, material, equipment, etc. for the **MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE, REDUCTION GEAR CASE OIL REPLACEMENT** including but not limited to the following:

- Removal and disposal of existing Citgo EP Compound Oil of the four (4) Reduction Gear Boxes for the MLK Bridge
- Flushing of the Gears and Gear Box
- Replacement of the oil with an approved synthetic oil

The project is expected to begin in June of 2015, when the ambient temperature is 50 degrees Fahrenheit or above. Coordination of the work between the City of Toledo and the U.S. Coast Guard will allow for four days when river traffic will halted and the bridge shall not be opened.

There will be a pre-Bid conference and site visit held at the Division of Streets, Bridges and Harbor, 1020 Water Street, Tuesday, February 3, 2015 at 1:00 PM local time. Attendance at the Pre-Bid conference is strongly encouraged.

Neither Owner nor Engineer has any responsibility for the accuracy, completeness or sufficiency of any bid documents obtained from any source other than the source indicated in these documents. Obtaining these documents from any other source(s) may result in obtaining incomplete and inaccurate information. Obtaining these documents from any source other than directly from the source listed herein may also result in failure to receive any addenda, corrections, or other revisions to these documents that may be issued.

Contractor and all Subcontractors will be required to conform to the labor standards and employment requirements set forth in the Contract Documents. The City of Toledo has a goal orientated MBE Program that specifies a 15.0% MBE goal in construction contracts. This goal applies to prime contracts as well as subcontracts. Bidders are expected to make a good faith effort to locate and solicit bids from MBE companies for subcontract activity.

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no Bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 120 days after the actual opening thereof.

Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid that is deemed most favorable to Owner.
